

Educational Resources provides scientific poster printing services for The University of Georgia.


Our high resolution, large format printer creates full color posters up to 44" wide by almost any length and uses fade and water resistant inks.

We now have two print materials:

- **Premium Glossy Photo Paper**- our traditional poster paper that easily rolls to fit in a tube
- **Durable Fabric**- convenient, water proof, able to be folded to travel in a suitcase\*

**Note- Our 44" wide Fabric has a 72" length limit; our 36" wide Fabric does not.**

While posters are printed on a first come, first served basis, we typically have a 24-hour turnaround time during regular business hours. We will usually have a poster ready for pick up by 5PM the following day it has been submitted. We do not print on weekends. A \$10 rush fee may apply to posters needed in less than 24 hours unless scheduled in advance. Please plan ahead. We also offer a small, low-cost proofing print to check your work or hang in your office.

### Some things to keep in mind when submitting a poster...

Currently, we print from PDF files. If a poster is submitted as another file type such as PowerPoint, we will create a PDF file from it and send it back for final proofing. This may add extra time to the poster printing process.

Maximum print size, including a 1/8" white border, is 44"x 96." A \$5 charge will be assessed to remove this border if desired. Contact us if you require a poster longer than 8 feet to see if we can accommodate you.

There is a 15MB file size limit for attachments when submitting a poster using our form. If you have a file larger than 15MB, you may need to bring it by on a flash drive or send us a link using Dropbox or another such service.

\*12x12x1 inch travel box included. A minimal light ironing may be desired to eliminate folds that may occur during storage.
